



D. BRUCE LOCKERBIE: INTRODUCTION TO ABHE FLAGSHIP PRESIDENTS

- Both parents were Depression Era school dropouts and reared in godless homes
- Father E. A. Lockerbie converted at Earls court Citadel, Toronto; ordained by Associated Gospel Churches; later Fellowship of Baptists and GARBC affiliations
- Mother Jeanette Honeyman Lockerbie Johnston converted at Delta Tabernacle, Hamilton, ON; author of many best-selling books
- DBL born 1935 to Canadian church-planters in Northern Ontario
- PK in Hamilton, Beamsville, Guelph, Ontario; Haslett, Michigan and Brooklyn, New York
- High school coach: “Run the race of your life, kid, and maybe God has a surprise for you”
- Full grant to attend New York University (1952-1956); English major, Religion minor
- World-ranked middle distance runner for NYU and New York Athletic Club
- Wheaton College 1956-57, English instructor / assistant track coach to Gil Dodds
- The Stony Brook School 1957-1991 under Frank E. Gaebelein for six years; taught English, Bible, conducted choral music, coached cross country and track & field
- Chair, English Dept, and Fine Arts Dept, Dean of Faculty, and Thomas F. Staley Foundation Scholar-in-Residence
- Taught sons/daughters of “evangelical household names” such as Boice/Bright/Graham/Hines/Howard/Koop/Lindsell/Olford/Ortlund.Perkins/Skinner/Wirt/Zodhiates
- M. A. New York University, American Civilization (“Christian Orthodoxy in *Moby-Dick*”)
- Honorary degrees awarded by Eastern University and Taylor University
- Author, co-author, editor of 40+ books
- Visiting Scholar, Visiting Professor, or Lecturer at schools, colleges/universities, seminaries
- Twice Dept of Religion Lecturer at Chautauqua Institution
- Twice keynote speaker at ABHE’s 50th and 60th conventions; author *AABC General Studies in the Bible College* (1990)
- Founder, PAIDEIA, Inc. 1965. Consultant throughout North America, Europe, Africa, Asia, Central and South America

Influence of uncle John Honeyman: Grade-school dropout in Scotland/arrived in Canada with father/converted through testimony of boyhood friend/offered education by Presbyterian pastor (University of Western Ontario/Knox Theological College/ordained and pastor in Ontario/joined faculty of London Bible Institute (later dean at Toronto/Ontario/Tyndale College & Seminary/petitioned UWO to accept academic credits for Samuel J. Mikolaski (later D.Phil. Oxford) as first Bible college graduate in Canada to overcome secular universities’ rejection.

Ironically, as John Honeyman himself pursued a theological doctorate from University of Toronto, each chapter of his dissertation received “Highest Honors” as submitted. But when the finished document was presented and he sat for his oral examination, he was informed that U of T “could not confer the degree upon a Bible college dean.” I come before you in honor of John Honeyman’s accomplishments, in spite of the academic injustice done to him by academic elitism.
