Dear President Granados:

The ABHE Commission on Accreditation reviewed Southeastern Bible College (AL) at its June 28, 2017 meeting and took the following action:

- **Order Southeastern Bible College (AL) to show cause by September 15, 2017, why its accredited status should be continued in light of the Commission's judgement that the institution fails to comply with the following ABHE Conditions of Eligibility and Standards**
 - **COE 8 (Faculty Qualifications)**
 - **COE 13 (Student Body)**
 - **COE 18 (Income Allocation)**
 - **Standard 6a (Human Resources)**
 - **Standard 6b (Financial Resources)**
 - **Standard 9 (Faculty)**

Placement on show cause does not become final until the institution has had an opportunity to request a review or appeal of the decision. I wrote to you on June 29, 2017 to notify you of this action and the opportunity to request a review or appeal. Since no request for review or appeal was filed during the 10-day allotted time, **the decision of the ABHE Commission on Accreditation is final, effective today, July 13, 2017.**

Within 30 days, the institution must publish notice of the action as stated below to its website.

The ABHE Commission on Accreditation has issued Southeastern Bible College an order to show cause why its accreditation should be continued. An institution retains its accreditation with the Commission on Accreditation while under show cause order. The maximum time permitted for a show cause order is one year. Failure to comply with the following specific accreditation standards by the deadline imposed by the Commission on Accreditation will result in removal of the institution's status with the Commission on Accreditation.

The institution's response to the Show Cause order will be reviewed by the Commission on Accreditation at its November 2017 meeting. I will notify of the Commission's decision by late November. An approved teach-out plan is on file.
