Dear President Crummie:

The ABHE Commission on Accreditation (COA) reviewed your institution at its February 17-21, 2018 meeting and took the following action:

Withdraw accreditation from Carver College (GA) in light of the Commission's judgment that the institution fails to comply with the following ABHE Standards:

- **Standard 3, EE 1, 4, 5, 6, 7**
 - **EE 1, failure to accurately represent the institution's accredited status to the public on website and catalog**
 - **EE 4, failure to meet obligations to employees on an equitable and consistent basis**
 - **EE 5, EE 6, repeated failure to consistently and in a timely fashion meet the reporting requirements of the Commission on Accreditation and to provide sufficient evidence of the fulfillment of applicable standards, policies, and procedures (Policy and Procedures for Monitoring Annual Report Data, ABHE Bylaws, Article I, Section 1.3)**
 - **EE 7, failure to comply with USDE standards for the administration of federal financial aid**
- **COE 16, Standard 6a, EE 1, failure to consistently provide sufficiently qualified personnel to provide critical administrative, faculty, and student services**
- **Standard 6b, EE 1, 5, 6**
 - **EE 1, repeated failure to timely submit opinioned audits**
 - **EE 5, lack of governance oversight as evidenced by the institution's repeated failure to provide timely financial information and to comply with USDE regulations**
 - **EE 6, failure to provide sufficient reserves to enable effective response to unforeseen financial circumstances**

- **Standard 7c, EE 1, 2**
 - **EE 1, failure to provide accurate and current financial aid information in regard to the availability of financial aid information on the website to prospective and enrolled students**
 - **EE 2, a history of deficiencies in financial aid practices leading to the institution's loss of Title IV funding**

Involuntary withdrawal/termination of accreditation is an appealable action, and such action is not final until the option of appeal had been exhausted. Carver College requested a face-to-face appeal, which was held on June 13, 2018. The Appeal Panel reviewed documentation from the February COA meeting, appeal documentation supplied by the institution on March 23, 2018, and testimony and responses to questions by you and your representative during the appeal meeting.

The decision of the Appeal Panel was to uphold the COA decision as stated above. The effective date of this action is June 13, 2018. This is a final action.

Any official comments that the institution may wish to make in response to the decision that are received at coa@abhe.org by August 13, 2018 will be made available to (1) the U.S. Department of Education, (2) state and provincial postsecondary education offices, (3) recognized accrediting agencies, and (4) the public. If no comments are offered, ABHE will document that the institution was provided opportunity to make comments.
