Dear President Martini:

The ABHE Commission on Accreditation reviewed your institution at its February 12, 2020 meeting and took the following action:

Continue Horizon Bible College & Seminary (SK) on warning and continue accreditation in light of the Commission on Accreditation's judgment that the institution marginally complies with the ABHE Institutional Accreditation Condition of Eligibility and Standards listed below and require a special progress report, due November 15, 2020, documenting compliance with the following:

- **COE 19 (a financial base indicating that the institution can achieve its mission and goals within a balanced budget and at a safe level of debt)**
- **Standard 6b, EE 3 (cultivation of adequate revenue streams sufficient to realize institutional goals)**
- **Standard 6b, EE 6 (Sufficient financial reserves to enable effective response to unforeseen financial circumstances and enrollment fluctuations)**

Until the institution is removed from warning, the institutional website must disclose that the institution is on warning status (Policy on Communication of Accreditation Decisions).

The effective date of this action is February 12, 2020. Please see the revised Report Guide at www.abhe.org/accreditation/accreditation-documents/ for assistance in formatting and submitting any required reports to the Commission.

In addition to the progress report noted above, institutional representatives will be expected to meet with the Commission on Accreditation at the February 2021 meeting to respond to any questions the Commission may have prior to the Commission making a decision on the institution's accreditation status.
