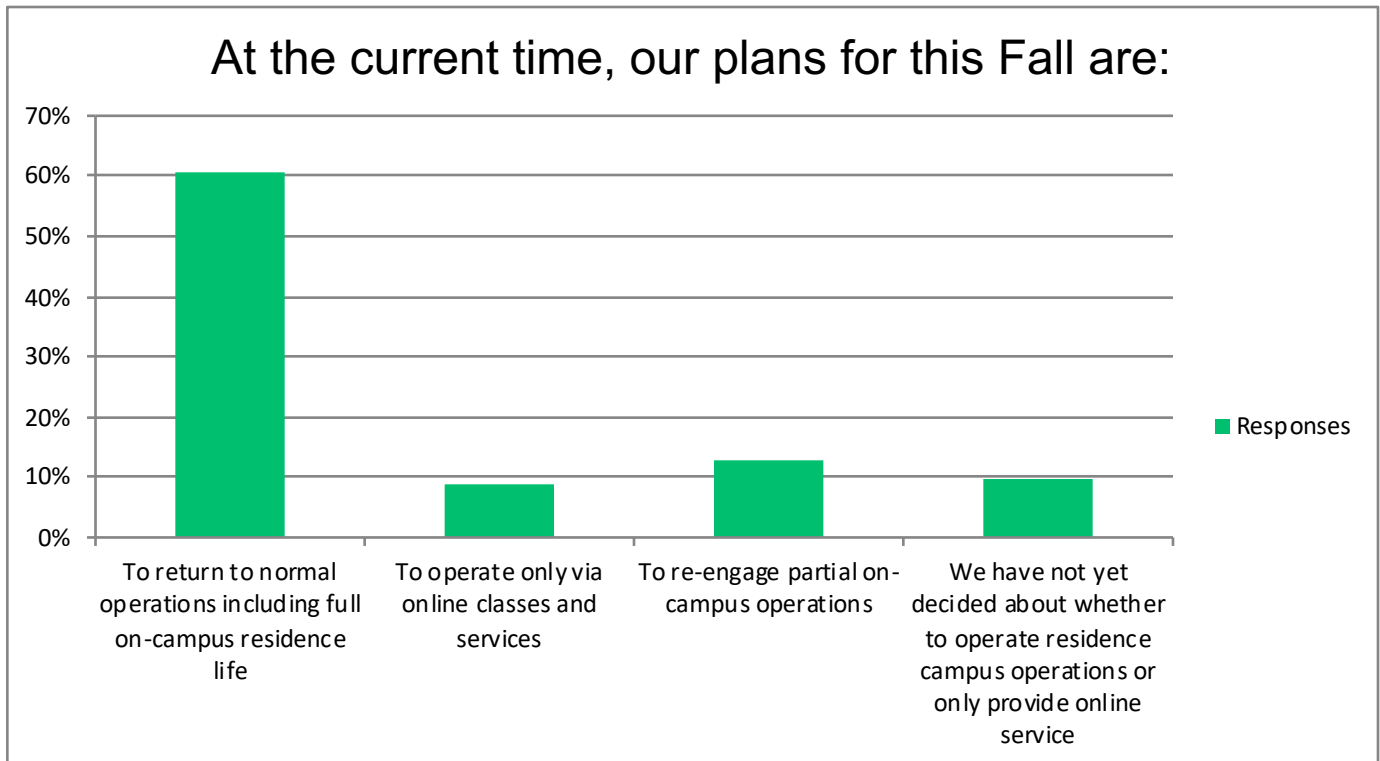


FALL 2020 PLANNING STATUS UPDATE

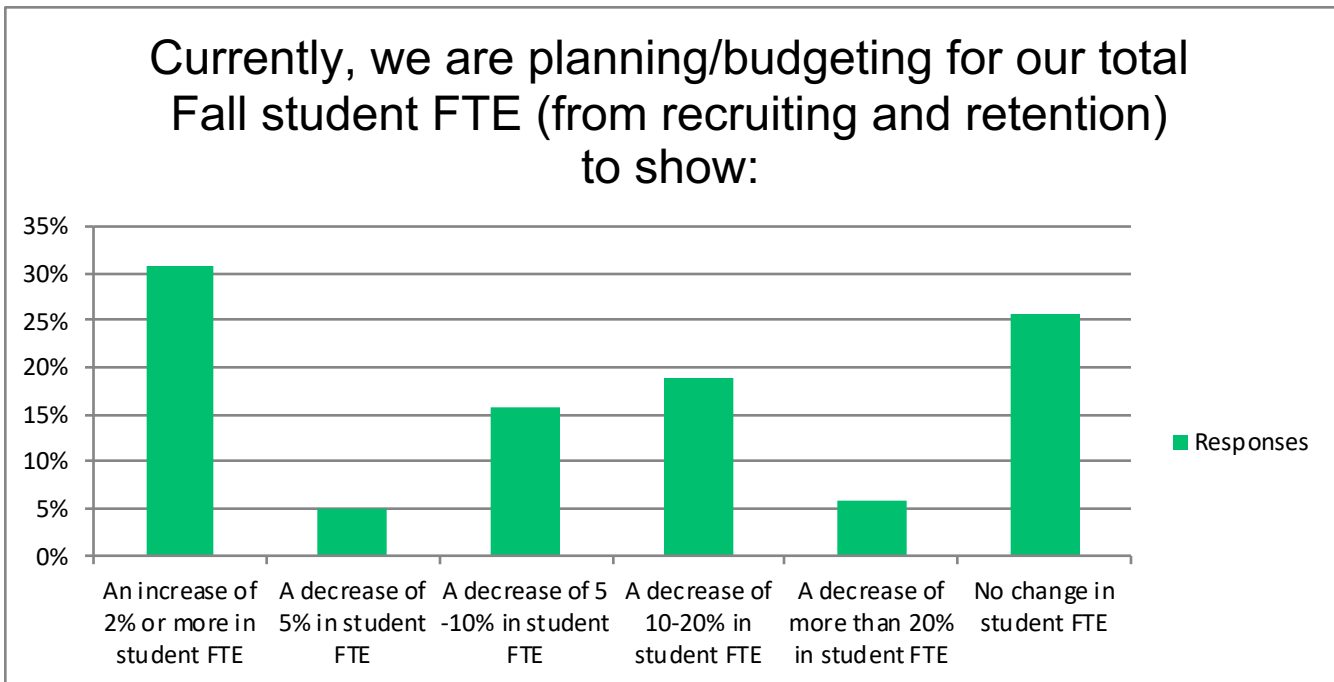
Other Comments:

Currently, we are planning/budgeting for our total Fall student FTE (from recruiting and retention) to show:

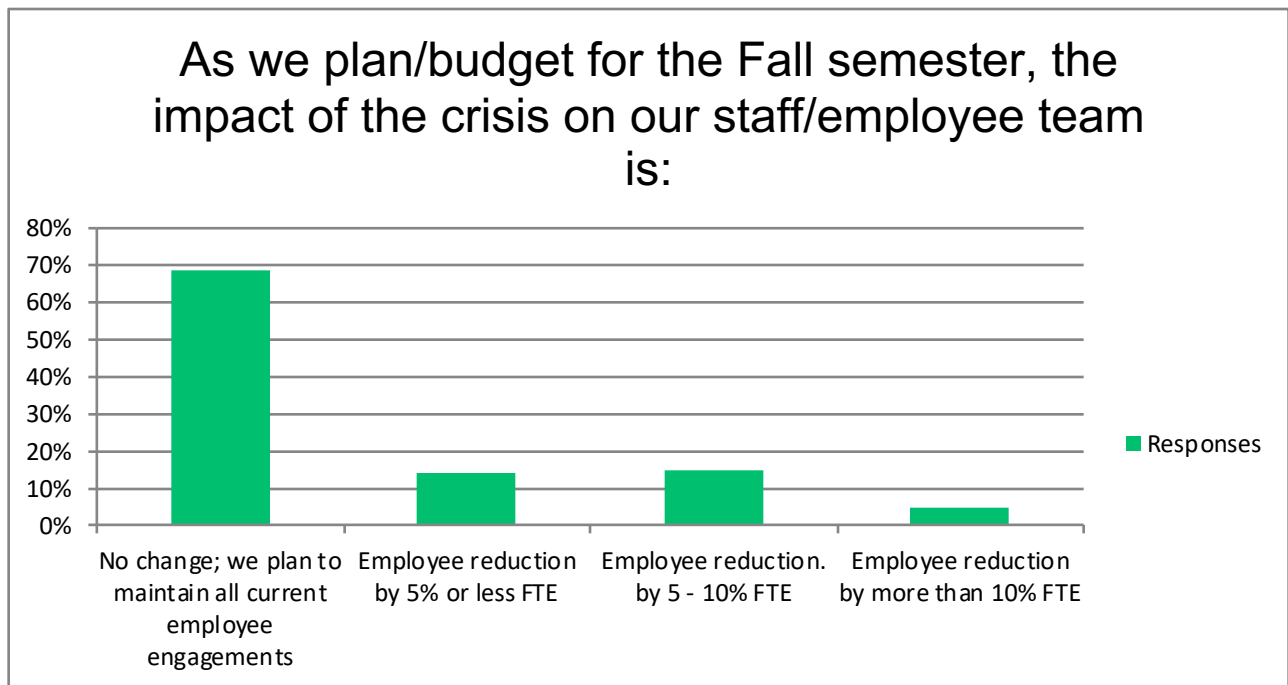

As we plan/budget for the Fall semester, the impact of the crisis on our staff/employee team is:

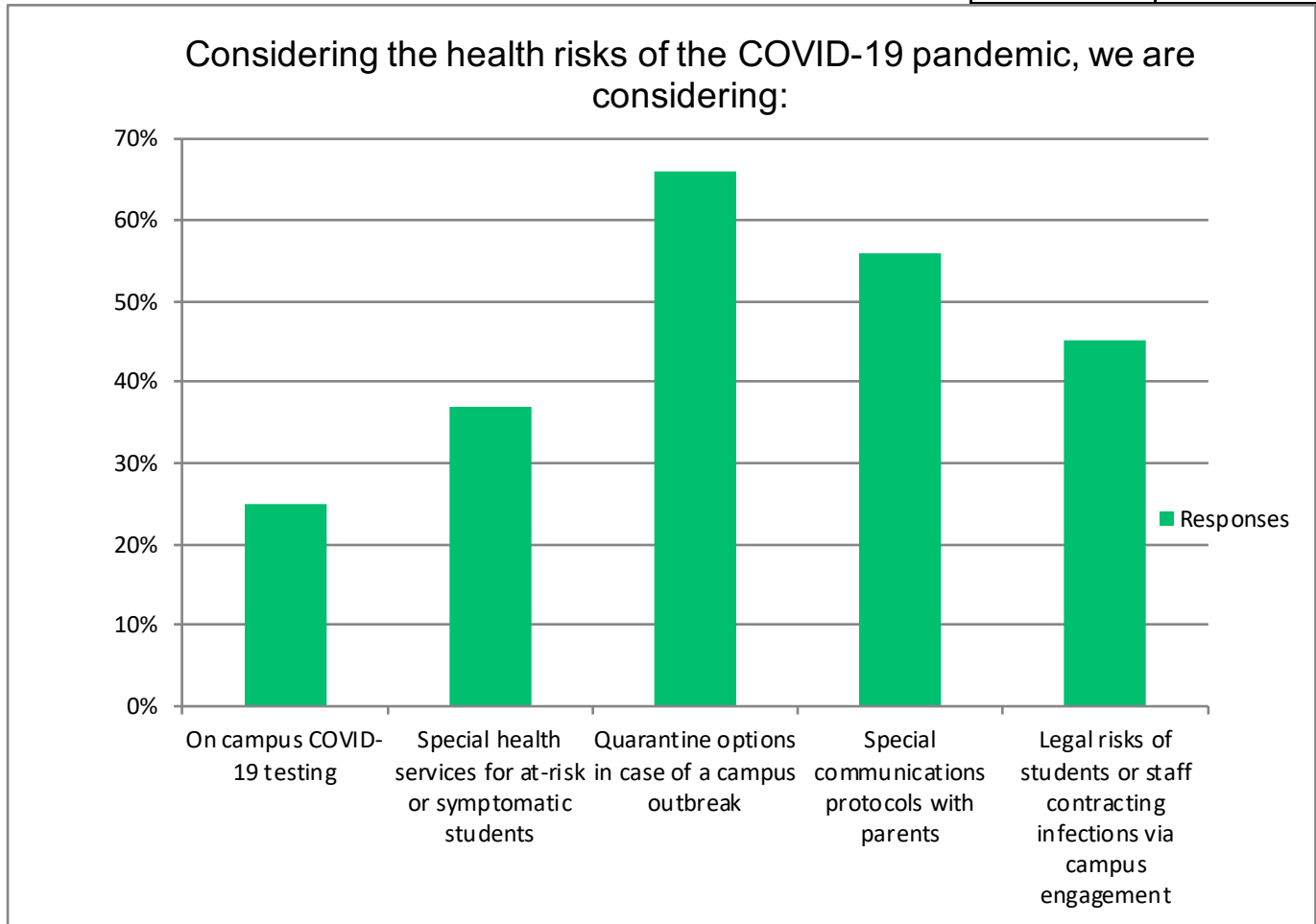
