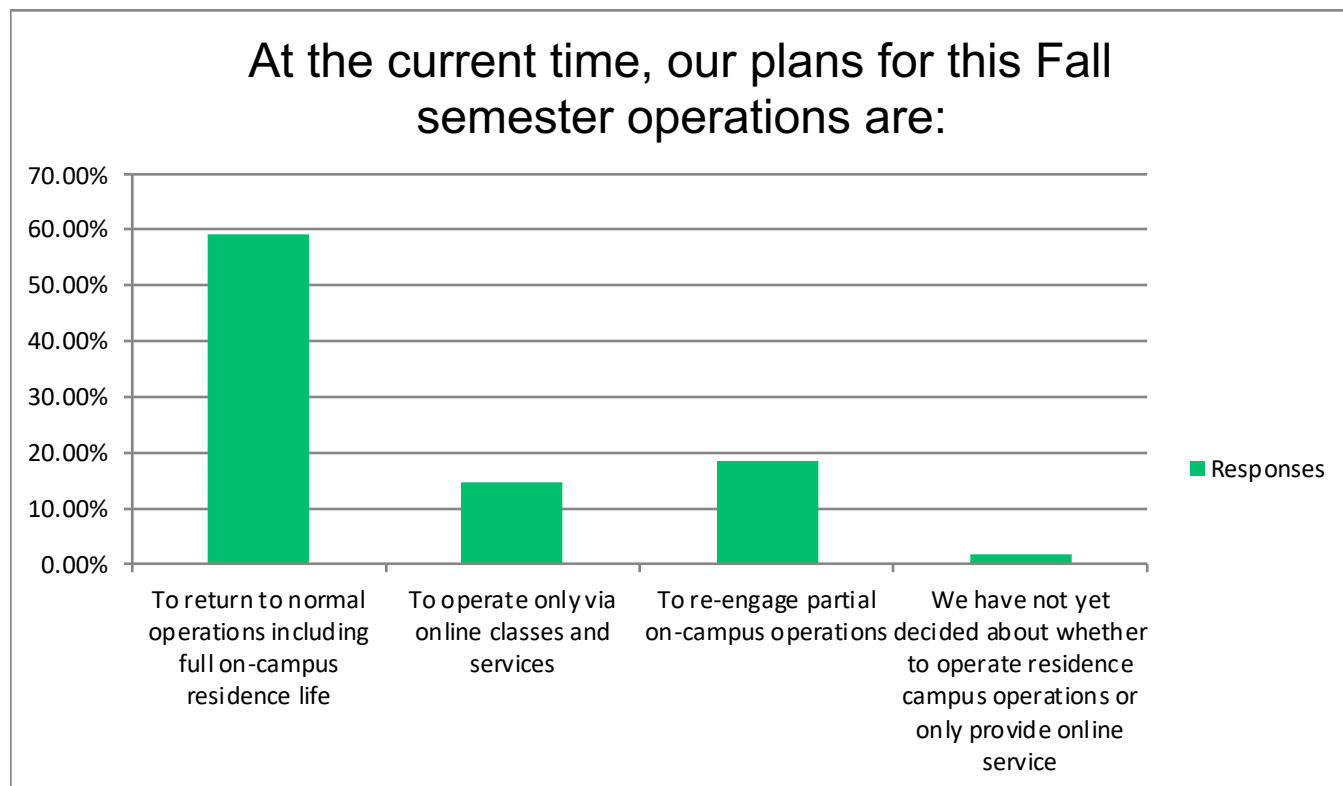


FALL 2020 PLANNING STATUS UPDATE AS OF JULY 1

Other Comments

We are using a "multi-access campus" approach: First 7 weeks, freshman start on campus, upperclass start "online". At Reading Week, we flip and the roles are reversed. Meanwhile, all classes will be streamed and can be taken remotely if students prefer to stay away from the campus.

We may adjust to in class activities as Alberta Health Services recommends

We want Students back on campus and preparing according to CDC Guidleness, however we will be prepared if all courses go on-line if the need arises.

We are an online only institution

In-person classes and residence life with social distancing changes including classes at 1/3 capacity, with a compressed fall schedule shifting to online after Thanksgiving break

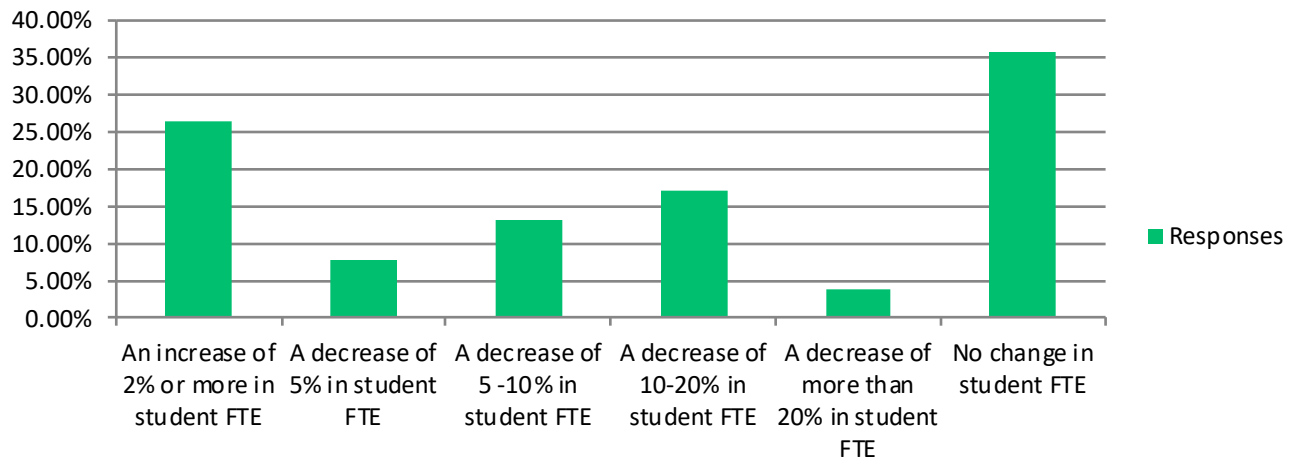
Our Board of Directors have engaged to attend workshops with ABHE this Fall.

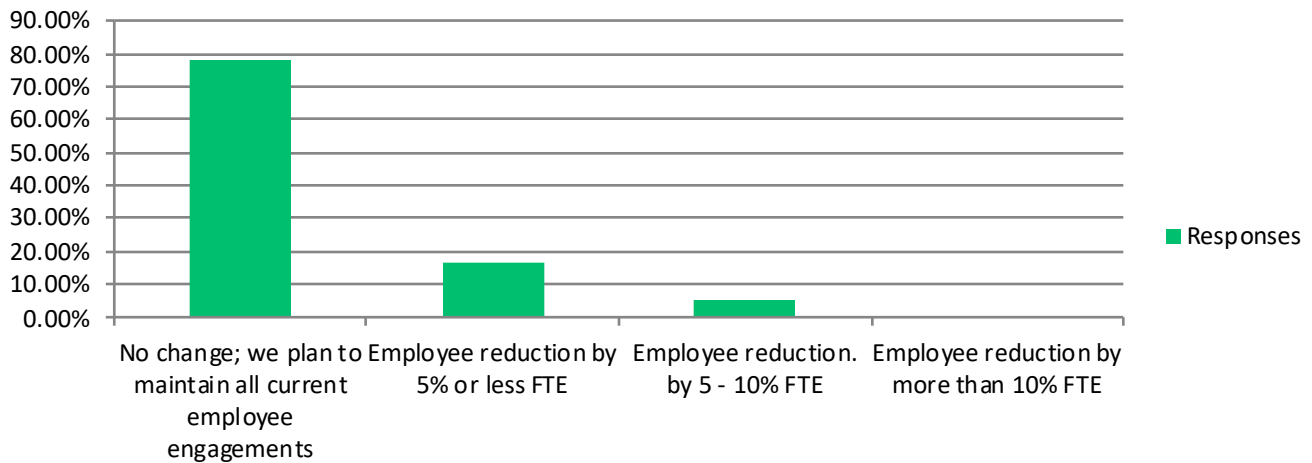

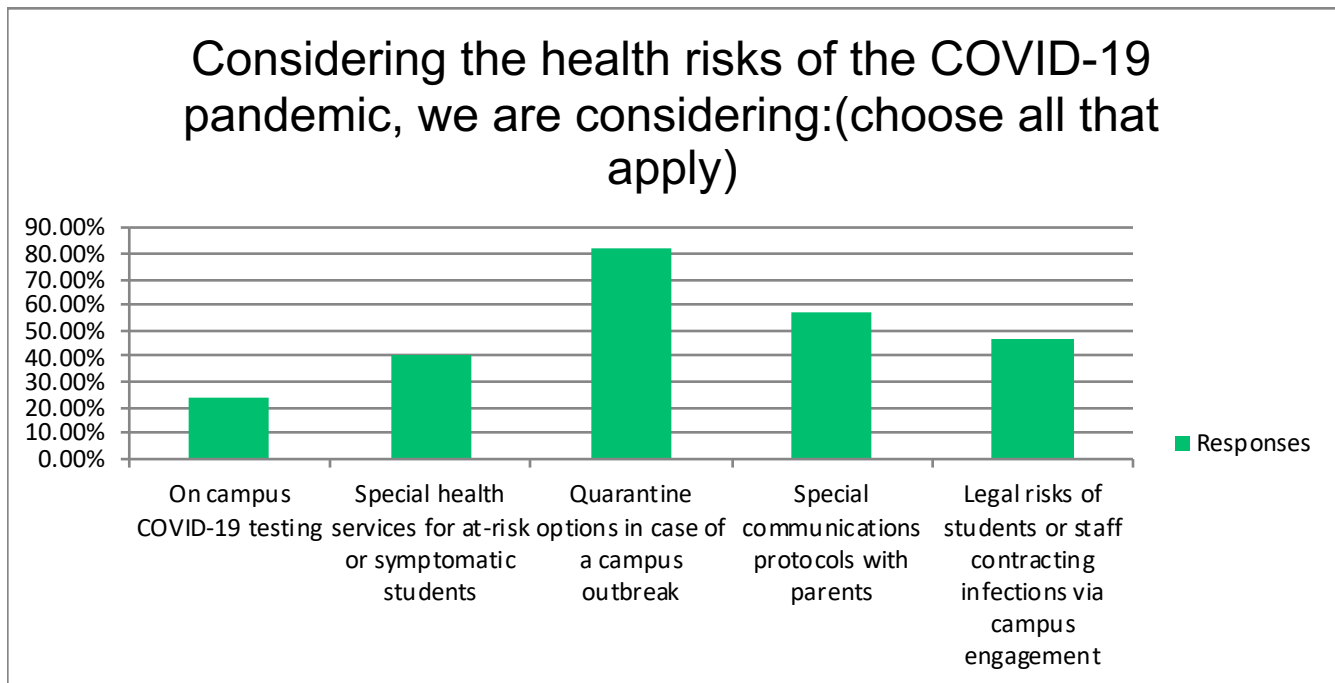

All our classes are online at this time

Self Reporting App
All students will be placed in "hubs" or "bubbles" and will "do college life" together. This will allow for more
