STATEMENT OF ACCREDITATION:

Olivet University is accredited by the Association for Biblical Higher Education Commission on Accreditation (COA). The institution was last reviewed by the COA in November 2021. The next comprehensive team visit will be conducted in the spring of 2023, followed by a COA review for reaffirmation of accreditation in February 2024. The institution's current status expires February 28, 2024, unless the COA takes other action before that date.

The institution was granted reaffirmation of accreditation in February 2014 on the basis that it evidenced substantial compliance with ABHE's Institutional Accreditation Standards, including documentation of the appropriateness, rigor, and achievement of its stated student learning outcomes and all other Title IV eligibility requirements. In the COA's judgment, the institution had no significant deficiencies in satisfying the Institutional Accreditation Standards or the related Essential Elements within the Standards at that time. The institution is currently in good standing with the ABHE Commission on Accreditation and no sanctions (warning, probation, show cause why accreditation should be continued) are in effect.

Institutional accreditation applies to the institution as a whole and includes all educational programs offered by the institution.

An **additional location** is a facility that is geographically apart from the main campus of the institution and at which the institution offers at least 50% of a program through classroom courses, hybrid courses, or a combination of both. An additional location may qualify as a branch campus and be subject to requirements pertaining to branch campuses. An **extension site** is an off-campus location where less than 50% of a degree program may be earned by classroom courses, hybrid courses, or a combination of both.
