Dear President Anderson:

Greetings in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ. This letter is your official notification of ABHE Commission on Accreditation actions relative to Providence University College and Theological Seminary. The ABHE Commission on Accreditation reviewed your institution at its February 11-15, 2023 meeting and took the following actions:

**Continue Providence University College and Seminary (MB) on warning and continue accreditation in light of the Commission on Accreditation's judgement that the institution marginally complies with the ABHE Institutional Accreditation Standards as listed below, and require a progress report due November 15, 2023, addressing the following:**

- **Standard 2: EE 1, 5, 7 (demonstrate with evidence the creation and implementation of an institutional assessment plan)**
- **Standard 2: EE 4, 6 (demonstrate with evidence at least one cycle of assessment in at least one undergraduate program and one graduate program completed within the last year)**

The effective date of these actions is February 15, 2023. Please see the Report Guide at [www.abhe.org/accreditation/accreditation-documents/](http://www.abhe.org/accreditation/accreditation-documents/) for assistance in formatting and submitting any reports required by the Commission.

In addition to the report indicated above, the institution will be expected to send representatives to meet with the COA at the February 2024 meeting to respond to questions and provide clarifications regarding further progress in addressing the concerns. At that time, the COA will act to remove warning or impose another sanction, depending on the progress made in strengthening compliance with the ABHE Standards noted above.
