Dear President Shuttlesworth:

Greetings in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ. This letter is your official notification of ABHE Commission on Accreditation actions relative to Northpoint Bible College. The ABHE Commission on Accreditation reviewed your institution at its February 10-14, 2024 meeting and took the following action:

Continue Northpoint Bible College (MA) on warning and continue accreditation in light of the Commission on Accreditation judgment that the institution marginally complies with the ABHE Institutional Accreditation Standards listed below, and require a progress report, due November 15, 2024, that includes a detailed financial recovery plan with three years of projected revenues and expenses, and addresses the following concerns:

- **Standard 6b: EE 1 (Demonstrate with evidence the financial stability of the institution, especially in light of the operating deficit and the “going concern” disclosure in the FY 2023 financial audit)**
- **Standard 6b: EE 2 (Demonstrate with evidence that the institution has implemented a budgeting process that serves as an effective instrument of financial oversight and planning)**
- **Standard 6b: EE 3 (Demonstrate with evidence the cultivation of adequate revenue streams sufficient to realize institutional goals)**
- **Standard 6b EE: 6 (Demonstrate with evidence that the institution possesses sufficient financial reserves to enable an effective response to unforeseen financial circumstances and enrollment fluctuations)**

The effective date of this action is February 14, 2024. Please see the Report Guide at www.abhe.org/accreditation/accreditation-documents/ for assistance in formatting and submitting any reports required by the Commission.

In addition to the report indicated above, the institution will be expected to send representatives to meet with the COA at the February 2025 meeting to respond to questions and provide clarifications regarding further progress in addressing the concerns. At that time, the COA will act to remove warning or impose another sanction depending on the progress made in strengthening compliance with the ABHE Standards noted above.
