Dear President Anderson:

Greetings in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ. This letter is your official notification of ABHE Commission on Accreditation actions relative to Providence University College and Theological Seminary. The ABHE Commission on Accreditation reviewed your institution at its February 10-14, 2024 meeting and took the following actions:

Approve the progress reported by Providence University College and Theological Seminary (MB) regarding Standard 2: EE 1, 5, 7 and Standard 2: EE 4, 6; and require that the self-study due to the Commission office (coa@abhe.org) eight weeks prior to the Evaluation Team Visit in Spring 2025, address the following concerns:

- **Standard 2: EE 1, 5 (Demonstrate with evidence the continued development and completed implementation of the institutional assessment plan).**
- **Standard 2: EE 4, 6 (Demonstrate with evidence continued progress with additional assessment cycles for other academic programs).**
- **Standard 2: EE 7 (Demonstrate with evidence written, comprehensive institutional improvement plan based on assessment results and aligned with realistic resource projections)**

Continue Providence University College and Theological Seminary (MB) on warning and continue accreditation in light of the Commission on Accreditation's judgement that the institution marginally complies with the ABHE Institutional Accreditation Standards listed below; and require a progress report, due May 15, 2024, that includes a written financial recovery plan with revenue and expense projections for the next three years, and addresses the following:

- **Standard 6b: EE 1 (Demonstrate with evidence financial stability by an independent, opinioned audit).**
- **Standard 6b: EE 2 (Demonstrate with evidence a budgeting process that serves as an effective instrument of financial oversight and planning).**
- **Standard 6b: EE 3 (Demonstrate with evidence cultivation of adequate revenue streams sufficient to realize institutional goals).**
- **Standard 6b: EE 6 (Demonstrate with evidence sufficient financial reserves to effectively respond to unforeseen financial circumstances and enrollment fluctuations).**
- **Standard 6b: EE 8 (Demonstrate with evidence that institutional planning informs the budgeting process).**

The effective date of these actions is February 14, 2024. Please see the Report Guide at www.abhe.org/accreditation/accreditation-documents/ for assistance in formatting and submitting any reports required by the Commission.

In addition to the report indicated above, the institution will be expected to send representatives to meet with the COA at the February 2025 meeting to respond to questions and provide clarifications regarding further progress in addressing the concerns. At that time, the COA will act to remove warning or impose another sanction depending on the progress made in strengthening compliance with the ABHE Standards noted above.
