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8. ABHE utilizes a 10-year accreditation cycle. What are the institutional challenges with a 10-year cycle? How could institutional quality be assessed more effectively between visits? Should the Commission consider a shorter cycle?
9. How could communication about COA policies and processes be improved?
10. What additional accreditation documents/resources would you find most helpful?
