Dear President Anderson:

Greetings in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ. This letter is your official notification of ABHE Commission on Accreditation actions relative to Providence University College and Theological Seminary. The ABHE Commission on Accreditation reviewed your institution at its February 15-19, 2025 meeting and took the following action(s):

**Continue Providence University College and Theological Seminary (MB) on warning and continue accreditation in light of the Commission on Accreditation's judgment that the institution marginally complies with the ABHE Institutional Accreditation Standards listed below, and require a progress report, due November 15, 2025, addressing the following concerns:**

- **Standard 5: EE 2 (Demonstrate with evidence financial stability, including adequate revenue streams to realize institutional mission and sufficient financial reserves to enable effective response to unforeseen financial circumstances and enrollment fluctuations)**
- **Standard 5: EE 3 (Demonstrate with evidence a budgeting process, informed by institutional planning, that serves as an effective instrument of financial oversight)**

The effective date of this action is February 19, 2025. Please see the Report Guide at [www.abhe.org/accreditation/accreditation-documents/](http://www.abhe.org/accreditation/accreditation-documents/) for assistance in formatting and submitting any reports required by the Commission.

Within seven days of receipt of this letter, the institution is required to update the information on its website regarding the reasons for its warning status (the Standards cited in the action above). Once updated, please screenshot the relevant page and submit it to [coa@abhe.org](mailto:coa@abhe.org).

In addition to the report indicated above, the institution will be expected to send representatives to meet with the COA at the February 2026 meeting to respond to questions and provide clarifications regarding further progress in addressing the concerns. At that time, the COA will act to remove warning or impose another sanction depending on the progress made in strengthening compliance with the ABHE Standards noted above.
