Dear President Shuttlesworth:

Greetings in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ. This letter is your official notification of ABHE Commission on Accreditation actions relative to Northpoint Bible College. The ABHE Commission on Accreditation reviewed your institution at its February 15-19, 2025 meeting and took the following actions:

Continue Northpoint Bible College (MA) on probation and continue accreditation for a second year in light of the Commission on Accreditation's judgment that the institution fails to comply with the ABHE Institutional Accreditation Standards listed below, and require a progress report, due November 15, 2025, addressing institutional compliance in the following areas:

- **Condition of Eligibility 20 (Documented evidence of a financial base sufficient to achieve institutional mission at a safe level of debt)**
- **Standard 5: EE 2 (Documented evidence of financial stability, including adequate revenue streams to realize institutional mission and sufficient financial reserves to enable effective response to unforeseen financial circumstances and enrollment fluctuations)**
- **Standard 5: EE 3 (Documented evidence of a budgeting process, informed by institutional planning, that serves as an effective instrument of financial oversight)**

Receive the explanation provided by Northpoint Bible College (MA) concerning Headcount Decrease and require a follow-up report, due May 15, 2025, addressing the following:

- **Standard 6: EE 1 (Documented evidence of a written, mission-focused enrollment management plan that addresses recruitment in light of enrollment decline)**

Note: The institution is required to provide a copy of this COA action letter to the State of Massachusetts upon receipt.

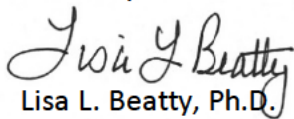
