Greetings in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ. This letter is your official notification of ABHE Commission on Accreditation actions relative to Barclay College. The ABHE Commission on Accreditation reviewed your institution at its June 16, 2025 meeting and took the following action:

Receive the explanation and improvement plan submitted by Barclay College (KS) concerning failure to submit FY 2023 and 2024 audits, management letters, and related Annual Institutional Update data; continue the institution on warning until February 2026 in light of continued failure to submit annual audits and financial data for the last two years; and require a progress report, due November 15, 2025, addressing the following concerns:

- **Standard 1: EE 2, Standard 5: EE 1, COE 22 (Demonstrated evidence of fulfillment of Commission policies and timely communication with the Commission regarding submission of an annual financial audit)**
- **Standard 5: EE 2, 5 (Demonstrated evidence of financial stability and adequate resources, including adequate revenue streams and sufficient financial reserves to support its mission, achieve educational goals, and ensure continuity of offerings)**

The institution is reminded that submission of the FY 2023 and FY 2024 audits, management letters, and related Annual Institutional Update data are required upon completion. Failure to submit these materials by the due date may result in additional sanction.

The effective date of this action is June 16, 2025. Please see the Report Guide at www.abhe.org/accreditation/accreditation-documents/ for assistance in formatting and submitting any reports required by the Commission.

Within seven (7) days, please update the warning notification on the institution's website with regard to the specific Standards and deficiencies noted in this action letter.
